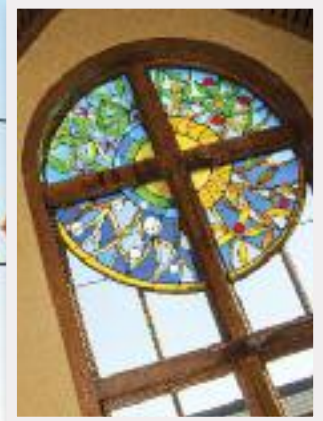

Family makes gift of \$10,000 to Ave Maria's Private Rooms in Loving Tribute to Parents

The family of the late Prince and Gladys Leonard has created a loving, lasting tribute in memory of their parents – a gift of \$10,000 to fund a private room as part of Ave Maria Village's capital campaign.

"It's a very worthwhile gift – a way to show how very much they were loved," the donor emphasizes. "It is well known that Ave Maria Village is a place to get excellent care when and if you need it."

The Leonards met when Gladys, a schoolteacher from Poplar, Mont., was auditioning actors for a play she directed. Prince, a native of St. John, N.D., got the part – and also got the girl. The couple were married in 1938, less than one year after their first date.

They made their home in the St. John area before moving to Jamestown. Prince and Gladys raised four children, Donald, Marilyn, Douglas and Marilys. They had nine grandchildren.

Prince headed the paint department at the North Dakota State Hospital for many years. He went on to work for Skeel's Painting & Decorating before eventually starting his own business, Prince Painting

and Decorating. He spent the final years of his career as paint manager at Schubert's Sales.

Gladys worked in the office at North Dakota Farmers Union and later as a social worker with Vocational Rehabilitation.

The couple were known as "real home bodies" who deeply valued their family and friends. They shared a passion for camping, often spending weekends in their camper at Jamestown Dam.

They were members of the First Baptist Church, and Prince belonged to the Moose Lodge. Gladys, who loved crocheting and baking, often cooked for family get-togethers on holidays and weekends. They built a house and moved to Arizona for two years after Prince's retirement, but missed the family so much that they sold it after only two years ... moving to Colorado, where most of their children lived.

Gladys passed away in 1994, and Prince in 2006.

Where does the time go? It seems we were just getting into the swing of spring ... and now the summer is flying past!

On the other hand, the remodeling of the kitchen here at Ave Maria Village seems to be moving ahead quite slowly. We have the money on hand to complete the first phase, which will cost \$126,000, but we can't get to work until the state of North Dakota okays our plans.

We're doing what we can while we await the state's okay. The maintenance department is moving the large ice machine out of the kitchen, down to one of the satellite kitchens. Then they'll make more room by turning around the coffee serving table.

After we get that approval and finish the first phase, we can move on to Phase Two – outfitting a room to be used solely for making desserts. The new under-counter refrigerator and freezer (*story on page 5*) will go there, along with a heavy-duty mixer that's been donated.. We'll also gain a large pantry for storing dry food. The total cost will be \$70,000; thanks to your generosity, we're already halfway there, with \$30,000 on hand.

Our volunteers are working on funding the new double-deck electric convection oven. Two fundraisers are coming up soon – root beer and orange floats on July 25 and 26, and our fourth annual Ave Maria Family and Friends Fun Walk Aug. 4. Please join us! (*See details on the back page.*)

We are so grateful to you who have already donated, financially and in kind. In addition to the appliances that have already been donated, others are on our "wish list": Some other appliances and items that are needed are:

- 36-inch restaurant-style range with 6 french hot plates and oversized oven, \$6,958
- Electric hot food serving counter, \$3,245
- Plastic Shelving, \$500, and Shelving Units, \$1,500

Meanwhile, we are still looking for lucky number 13 – the donor who will name the 13th private room with a gift of \$10,000. You can do it for a business, in memory or honor of someone, or for yourself. Let me know if you are interested. What a nice way to remember a loved one or to honor someone who means a lot to you! It could also be an especially nice thing to do for yourself.

I can't wait to get our whole kitchen project done so we can start on those private rooms for our residents. Some of them are sharing pretty small quarters with their roommates. That makes me more determined than ever to see this through.

We're sending out a big "thank you" to everyone who has given memorials for their loved ones , as well as all of the other things our friends are doing to make life at Ave Maria even better for our dear elderly. I can't put into words how much that means to all of us and how much it helps! Together, we're on our way to making our residents the happiest people around ... helping them truly thrive.

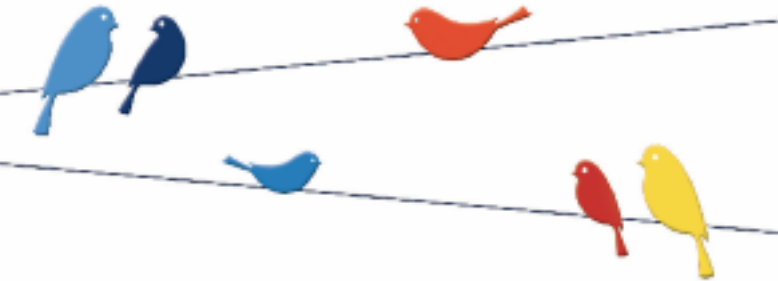
